Places of production of the elements of your jeans:

- a. The design is prepared in Switzerland and sent over the Internet to a clothing factory in the Philippines.
- b. Cotton is harvested in Burkina Faso, Kazakhstan, or India and sent to China.
- c. In China spun thread, using Swiss machines.
- d. In the Philippines, the cotton is dyed indigo color which came from Germany or Switzerland.
- e. In Poland, the material is woven using Swiss machines.
- f. The material is sent to Marseille in France.
- g. Label of the jeans came from France and buttons from Italy.
- h. All elements (buttons, labels, material) are transported by plane to the Philippines and stapled together.
- i. In Greece, the jeans are finished with a pumice stone.
- j. Jeans are sold in Switzerland.
- k. After being used in Europe they are given to the Red Cross or other organizations collecting used clothes.
- l. Jeans are sent to Africa, where they are worn again.
